PRACTICE NOTE  
CIVIL AND CRIMINAL  
(Withdrawal of Counsel)

There has developed a practice of solicitors and/or counsel filing a notice of appeal in a criminal or civil matter and thereafter disclaiming any interest in the matter on the basis that they no longer represent the person for whom the notice of appeal was filed. Once a firm or a person has held itself, himself or herself out as representing a party to an appeal it, he or she should continue to do so unless and until it, he or she has been excused by the Court.

The accepted practice in this case is to file an application for leave to withdraw as solicitor and/or counsel with notice to the opposing parties and to the client.
