The intention of the clinic is to offer summary legal advice, on a pro bono basis, to self-represented litigants dealing with wills and estates matters. Clinic volunteer lawyers **will not** be able to complete legal documents, but can provide basic legal assistance and guidance.

Volunteer lawyers will not be able to provide advice outside of the area of wills and estates.
