TRANSCRIPTS OF CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

Members of the Legal Profession and others are advised that persons requesting the Court Reporters' Office to provide a transcript of a civil proceeding will be provided with dubbed copies of the tapes of the proceeding whereby they then have the option of listening to the tapes or making their own arrangements for the preparation of the transcript.

The charge for a copy of the sound record of evidence or other proceedings is set out in No. 16 of Item "J" of the Appendix to Rule 55 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, 1986, at \$7.50 per tape.

Persons requesting a transcript of an oral decision or order will continue to be provided with the transcript at the charge set out in No. 15 of Item "J" of the Appendix to Rule 55 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, 1986, of \$3.00 per page to the person requesting the transcript and a charge of \$1.00 per page to each person requesting a copy.
