

Practice Note

Rule 29.08(3) – Filing of documents for use of the Court
(Chambers Applications)

Practitioners are reminded of the requirements of the Rules with respect to filing of documents in support of applications.

On a contested application, documents for the use of the Court shall be filed with the Registrar at least one clear day before the hearing. This means that an application with accompanying documents filed on a Monday cannot be heard by the Court before Wednesday, and so on.

On ex parte applications only, documents for the use of the Court shall be filed with the Registrar not later than twelve o'clock noon of the day preceding the hearing.

All practitioners and Registry staff are reminded to ensure compliance with these rules.
