

THE PROVINCIAL COURT OF NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR NOTICE TO THE PROFESSION AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC REVISED COVID-19 OPERATIONAL PLAN ISSUED JULY 29, 2022 LIFTING OF RESTRICTIONS

Effective Monday, August 1, 2022 and until further notice, the Provincial Court of Newfoundland and Labrador will lift its restrictions including capacity limits and physical distancing requirements. The public will have access to the courthouses; however, the presiding judge may limit access to the courtroom.

IN-CUSTODY ACCUSED

Arraignments, judicial interim release (bail) hearings and sentencings may be conducted inperson but the use of audio and video technology is encouraged.

The Accused will continue to attend their trials or preliminary inquiries in-person unless otherwise ordered by the judge.

PERSONS NOT IN-CUSTODY

If you are scheduled to appear in Court (first appearance, trial, preliminary inquiry, sentencing hearing or other hearing, or to vary an existing order), and you are not represented by counsel, you must appear in Court on your scheduled date. PARTIES REPRESENTED BY COUNSEL

Counsel are encouraged to file all applications electronically but in-person applications will be accepted.

Counsel are also encouraged to file designations of counsel where applicable.

For individual appearances by counsel, CourtCall may be used. Please contact the local courthouse as to whether a toll-free conference number is available.

VIRTUAL COURT

The Court will maintain its capacity to conduct virtual court. Parties are required to make an application for use of virtual court.

WEEKEND AND STATUTORY HOLIDAY COURT (WASH)

Current WASH court procedures remain unchanged. The general public will not be permitted to attend. All parties, including the Accused, will appear by audio or video technology. Media may attend using audio technology.

MASKING

Masking inside the public areas of the courthouses is strongly encouraged. Masking inside the courtrooms is also strongly encouraged but will be at the discretion of the presiding judge.

PUBLIC HEALTH GUIDELINES

If you are experiencing a COVID-19 related symptom, do not attend Court. You must contact the Court by telephone in advance of your scheduled appearance. (The number is listed below).
