COURT STAFF CANNOT PROVIDE LEGAL ADVICE

WE CANNOT:

- ▶ tell you if you should start a court case
- ▶ tell you if you should take a particular course of action
- ▶ tell you what words to put in a court form
- ▶ speculate about what decision a judge might make
- ▶ speculate about what sentence a judge might impose
- ▶ give you advice on how to present your case in court
- ▶ talk to a judge for you. You can only talk to a judge during a scheduled court appearance
