INFORMATION ABOUT THE PERSONAL HISTORY FORM

- 2. Applicants must provide documentary evidence of a Criminal Records Screening through a Canadian Police Information Centre (CPIC) and the Integrated Provincial Court Information System (IPCIS). The CPIC screen may be done through either the RCMP or the RNC. The IPCIS screen may be requested at any Provincial Court Centre in the province.
 - For convenience, appropriate application forms are enclosed, or are available through our website at www.court.nl.ca/provincial/judiciary.htm. They are also available through the police or court centres.
- 3. Provide any additional information that you believe will be useful when your application is reviewed. If the space provided in the Personal History Form is not sufficient, then attach additional pages. A *curriculum vitae* can also be attached but not as a substitute for completing the form. References whom you list on this Application may be contacted by the Council.

In making its enquiries, Council will exert every effort to urge and to maintain confidentiality. However, given its wide consultations, the Council cannot accept responsibility for unauthorized disclosure of an applicant's name.

Council assessments are confidential and are communicated to the Minister only. Assessments are valid for a period of two years, after which time a candidate may submit a new application for another assessment.
