Business Continuity Planning is an emergency planning process that enables the Court to continue essential services in the event of a disruption. An All Hazards Plan has been developed to provide the Court with a flexible, adaptable framework to enable an effective response to a wide range of disruptions.

The main goals of the plan are to;

- 1. Maintain/preserve the rule of law
- 2. Continue the Court's essential functions and operations
- 3. Minimize risks to the health and safety of the public, staff and judiciary
- 4. Reduce or minimize property damage and loss
- 5. Protect essential facilities, equipment, and records
- 6. Recover and resume normal operations.

The plan includes preparation for modified or reduced services to the public depending on the effects a disruption might have on our staff, the public and other groups such as lawyers, police and sheriff's officers.
