### What happens at the payment hearing?

Evidence may be heard about any of the following:

- a) the income and assets of the debtor;
- b) the debts owed to and by the debtor;
- c) any assets that the debtor has disposed of since the claim arose;
- d) the means that the debtor has, or may have in the future, of paying the amount owed.

The Judge may order a payment schedule specifying

- a) the date by which the debt must be paid, or
- b) the amounts and dates of installments.

If you do not plan to attend you should let the court know that by letter.

### What happens if the creditor does not attend the payment hearing?

The Judge may hold the hearing, cancel it or postpone it.
