NOTICE TO THE PROFESSION Amendment to Rule 18A.06: Case Management Meetings

The Rules Committee of the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador, Trial Division, recently approved an amendment to Rule 18A.06 of the *Rules of the Supreme Court, 1986*. The amendment was published in the March 21, 2014 edition of the *Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette* and is effective as of that date (NL Reg. 25/14). It establishes a new procedure for requesting a case management meeting.

Requesting Case Management Meetings

Under the amended rule 18A.06(2), a party wishing to request a case management meeting must file a request for a case management meeting in Form 18A.06A. That form requires that the requesting party provide a list of the issues that that party wishes to address at the meeting along with other information relating to the timing of the meeting and the parties participating.
