Wireless Internet Access in Trial Division Courtrooms in St. John's

Starting on May 1, 2015, lawyers and self-represented parties needing wireless internet access in the courtrooms of the St. John's General Division and Family Division of the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador will be able to request access to an in-Court wireless network.

The wireless network will be in place to facilitate Court proceedings by allowing lawyers and parties to check email, access their schedules and conduct research. Persons seeking access to the wireless network will be required to complete a request form and agree to the Wireless Guest Access and Electronic Devices Policy which sets out terms of usage for both the network and electronic devices in the Courthouse. Requests must be submitted to the Registry in the Court Centre where access is sought. Access will be valid for a period of 30 days.
