### **NOTICE TO THE PROFESSION**

#### **Wireless Internet Access in Supreme Court in Corner Brook**

Starting on December 10, 2019, lawyers and self-represented parties needing wireless internet access in the courtrooms of the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador (General and Family Divisions) in Corner Brook will be able to request access to an in-Court wireless network.

The wireless network will be in place to facilitate Court proceedings by allowing lawyers and parties to check email, access their schedules and conduct research. Access will be valid for a period of 30 days.

Persons seeking access to the wireless network will be required to complete a **Wireless Internet Guest Access Request Form** and agree to the **Wireless Guest Access and Electronic Devices Policy**, which sets out terms of usage for both the network and electronic devices in the Supreme Court. Copies of the request form and usage policy will be available in all courtrooms and at the Registry. Requests must be submitted to the Registry in Corner Brook.
