NOTICE TO THE PROFESSION**

**COURT ATTIRE—SUMMER APPEARANCES**

The following Notice to the Profession outlines the expectations for counsel's court attire for appearances during the summer term, which runs from July 1 to September 6, 2024, inclusive. **This Notice applies to proceedings in both the General and Family Divisions and supplants, for the summer term, the Notice issued on March 10, 2016.**

The guidelines listed in this Notice are optional, and counsel who wish to dress in conformance with the earlier Notice will be permitted to do so.

**Attire Expectations**

Counsel appearing in any matter before the Court must ensure that they wear:

- A business suit, with or without a tie; and,
- Closed-toed shoes.

Unless they are appearing in a criminal trial, counsel will not be expected to gown.
