NOTE: SECTION 127 OF THE JUDICATURE ACT, 1986 PROVIDES AS FOLLOWS:

127. Every person to whom letters of probate or administration are granted shall, within one year after the issuance of the grant, file in the Registry
- (a) a full inventory and valuation of the estate of or to which the deceased was possessed or entitled to at the time of the death of the deceased;
 - (b) a full statement of the estate that has come into that person's hands, or into the hands of any other person by that person's order;
 - (c) a full statement of disbursements made by that person on account of that funeral expenses, debts and estate; and
 - (d) a full statement of the estate that outstanding or undisposed of.
